#### Prayer of Saint Ephrem the Syrian

**O Lord and Master of my life, keep from me the spirit of indifference and discouragement, lust of power, and idle chatter. (prostration)**

**Instead, grant to me Your servant, the spirit of wholeness of being, humble-mindedness, patience and love. (prostration)**

**O Lord and King, grant me the grace to be aware of my sins and not to judge my neighbour; for You are blessed, now and forever and forever. (prostration)**

**God, be merciful to me a sinner. O God cleanse me of my sins and have mercy on me. I have sinned without number. Forgive me, O Lord (4X)**

**Once more the entire prayer is recited without the usual prostrations.**



**One prostration is made at the conclusion.**
